Comprehensive Plan Committee Distributes Planning Questionnaire

The Comprehensive Plan Committee of the New Lebanon Planning Board has mailed 2,174 questionnaires, one to every individual registered to vote in the Town or identified on the property tax rolls as the owner of property in the Town. The questionnaire solicits facts about residents and property owners and their views on a broad range of planning-related issues.

The questionnaire is another method for obtaining public input to the Comprehensive Plan update underway, and complements the public planning workshops held on October 1 and 5.

Those workshops were attended by nearly 100 Town residents. A workshop for owners of businesses located in the Town, held on October 22, was attended by 22 business owners. Two more workshops are being planned, one for high school students and one for senior citizens.

According to Jack Yurish, chair of the committee, "The workshops have been very successful in helping citizens to identify their vision of the Town's future. The questionnaire offers another input opportunity. We are encouraging everyone to take the time to complete and return the questionnaire."

Completed questionnaires are anonymous and return postage is prepaid. Completed questionnaires should be returned as soon as possible and within 3 weeks. Information will be tabulated and used by the committee when drafting the Comprehensive Plan update.

The Comprehensive Plan Committee was created to present the Planning Board with an updated Comprehensive Plan. The Plan has not been updated officially since first adopted in 1965.
